Bring Back The Music is now enrolling students for our 2019 Spring After School program. Classes will begin on Monday - February 11th at our Community Performing Arts Education Center at Spencer.

Young people need positive outlets for creative self-expression, and many have a keen interest in the performing arts. Musical study develops critical thinking, self-discipline, self-esteem, self-confidence and teamwork. The goal of Bring Back The Music is to promote young people's natural love of music and to increase their appreciation of this art form while building their skills so they can express themselves using instruments such as the guitar or drums.



Curriculum includes:

Classes are held for beginning students on Monday and Tuesday evenings from 4:30pm until 6:30pm. Classes for intermediate and advanced students are held on Wednesday and Thursday evenings from 4:30pm until 6:30pm. Our 2019 spring after school program will begin Monday – February 11 through Thursday – May 16. Tuition for our after-school program is \$130.00 per month.
